NEW CONCERT SET TO ROCK LAKE GRAPEVINE FOR CHARITY OCTOBER 11

GRAPEVINE, TEXAS (August 27, 2026) – Live music and community giving will come together this Fall at **The Concert on Lake Grapevine**, an outdoor concert planned for Sunday, October 11 at Mariner Park Point, by the dam on Lake Grapevine.
